The **Chicagoland Emergency Vehicle Show** is Chicagoland's premier public safety event and the largest emergency vehicle show in the Midwest. 200 fire engines, police cars, ambulances, military and emergency management vehicles will be on display. The public can view amazing demonstrations by area public safety providers including vehicle crash extrications using medevac choppers, S.W.A.T. team high-risk entry maneuvers, a hazmat response, and an emergency vehicle obstacle course conducted by the Editor of Law and Order Magazine. Children's activities include fire trucks rides, water fights, and fire safety displays. Vendors will offer public safety related collectibles and memorabilia. Food and drinks will also be available during the show.

The **Chicagoland Emergency Vehicle Show** will take place on Saturday, August 6, 2005 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at I-88 and Randall Rd. in North Aurora, IL on show grounds provided by Aurora Pump Company and Oberweis Dairy and insured by the Village of North Aurora, North Aurora Days Festival. The event is free to the public and to preregistered emergency vehicles. Day of show registration is \$ 15.00. Vehicle check-in begins at 8 a.m. and the show opens to the public at 10 a.m.

The **Lights & Sirens Parade and Emergency Vehicle Cruise Night** will take place on Friday, August 5, 2005 in North Aurora, IL. Parade staging begins at 6:00 p.m. at Tinseltown Theaters, 320 S. Lincolnway (Rt. 31), North Aurora, IL. The parade starts at 7:00 p.m. (Parade route: north on Rt. 31 to John St., west to Willoway, north to Oak St., west to Randall Rd.) Arrival of the **Lights & Sirens Parade** at Oak and Randall kicks off the **North Aurora Days Festival** featuring our **Emergency Vehicle Cruise Night** along with live bands and plenty of food and drinks.

The **Aurora Regional Fire Museum Tour & Open House** will take place on Friday, August 5, 2005, from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. in the newly renovated Aurora Regional Fire Museum in Aurora, IL. The museum is located downtown in the old Central Fire Station built in 1894. Participants can browse the fire apparatus on display including a steam pumper on loan from Chicago and view rare fireground films in the Hayloft Theater. Parking for fire apparatus and show cars will be available in the museum parking lot and in the city parking lot across the street from the museum.

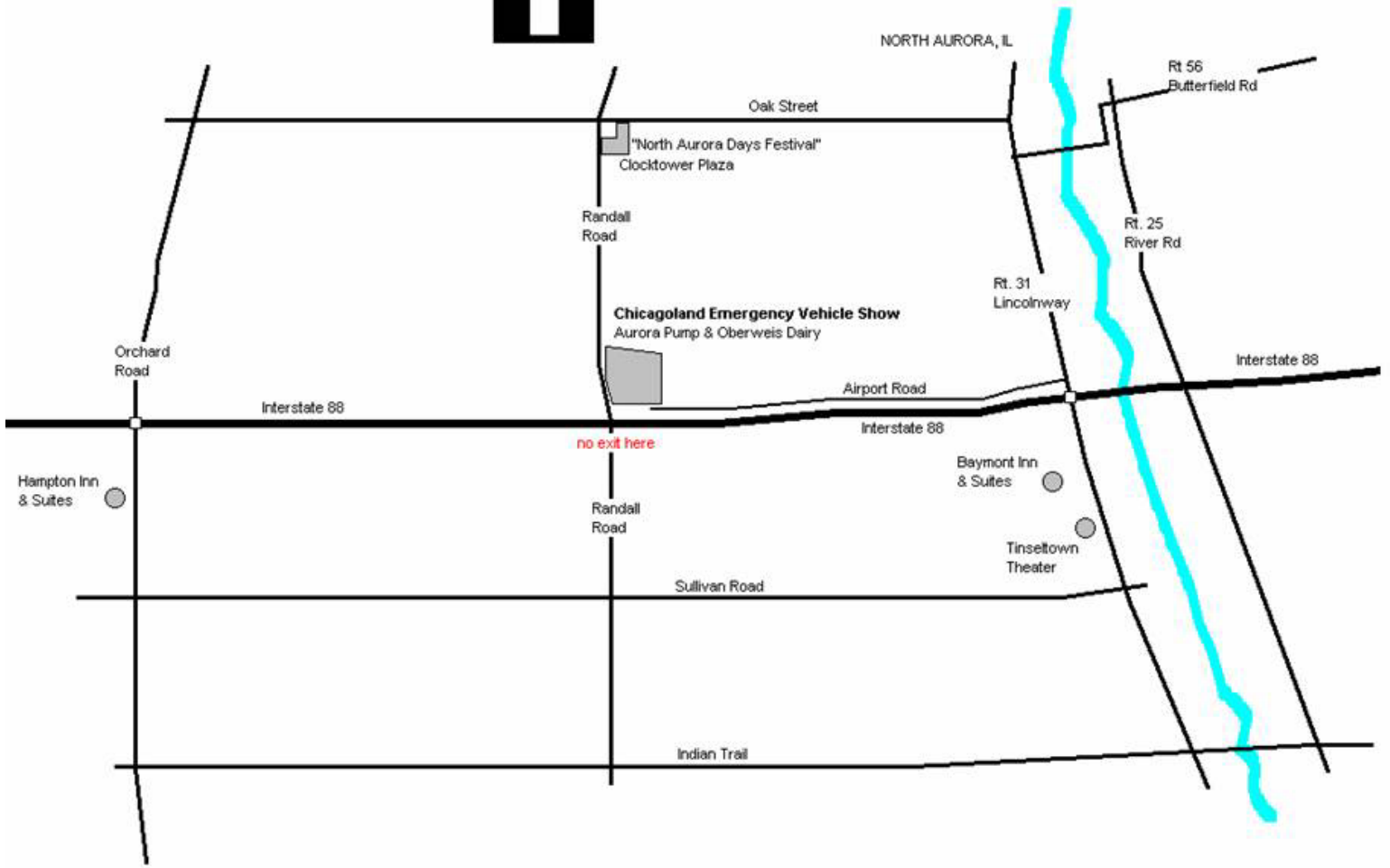
