General Instructions / Driver's Meeting

Four Classes

- A. 1969 and Older Vehicle (sedans from 20s, 30s, 40s, 50s, 60s)
- B. 1970 to 1989 Vehicle (sedans from 70s and 80s)
- C. 1990 to 2005 Vehicle (sedans from 90s and 00s)
- D. Special Service Police Vehicle (any modified sedan, any non-sedan)

We all want to do this again next year so NO INTENTIONAL BURNOUTS!

Prepare for the EVOC course

- Each driver must SHOW proof of insurance and SIGN the waiver
- Empty the trunk, except bolted down gear
- Empty the front and back seat, except bolted down
- Remove "full" wheel covers (optional)
- Check the air pressure in your tires, 30 psi, minimum
- Each car will have a CLASS and DRIVER NUMBER
- More than one driver can drive each car
- Only one car on the course at a time
- Run three (3) times maximum

During the EVOC course

- Must wear a helmet (one can and will be provided)
- Must wear a seat belt
- No passengers
- Turn on emergency lights ONLY but NO SIRENS (DQ)
- Wrong path around the course is an instant Disqualify (DQ)
- 3-second penalty for EACH pylon knocked over
- Watch for the FLAG MAN for course guidance
- Watch for the DIRECTIONAL (>>>>>) cones
- START from a stop, front wheels centered on a pylon (timer will assist you)
- FINISH when front wheels cross the last set of pylons, but STOP before hitting the center pylon
- Pay attention to EVOC officials for any additional instructions
